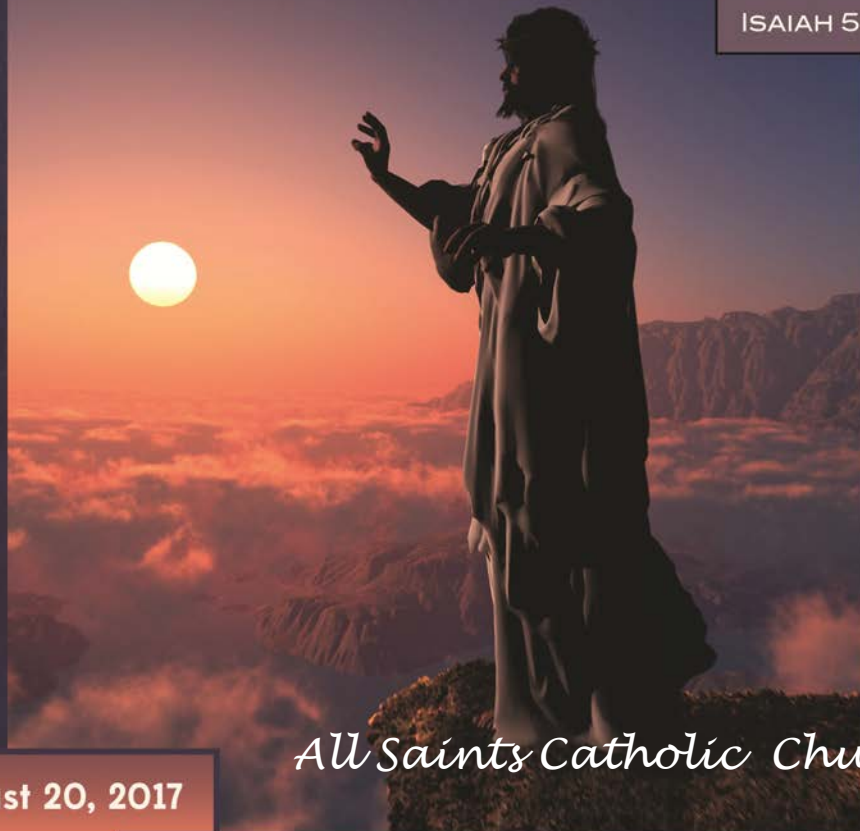

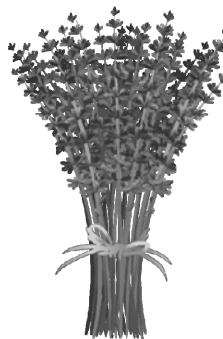

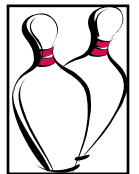
## “New” to All Saints Religious Education **PARENTING SUPPORT GROUP** All age groups

This weekend Rev. Peter Reddy, a priest from the Catholic Diocese of Warangal, South India (presently working on Loan for the Catholic diocese of Birmingham, Alabama) will preach a mission appeal in support of Evangelization work in Rural Tribal area in his diocese known as the TRIBAL/LAMBADA MISSION. It is the program of the diocese to carry the gospel message to these people. This tribe lives in a country side and deprived of the necessities like clean water, electricity, proper housing, education, healthcare and sanitation. They have their own DIALECT only to speak but without a script. The Bishop along with his priests, religious and a team of laity leaders are actively involved first to learn their language and catechizing them. Listen as he shares his love of Christ and the mission work and experiences as a missionary. A second collection will be taken for the work of evangelization for the mission in the diocese of Warangal. Thank you.

## SACRAMENTS

**Baptism:** The celebration of Baptism is a moment of Grace for those to be baptized, for their families, and for the entire Parish Community. Preparation class is held the last Tuesday of each month at 7pm. Please call the office to RSVP. A Parish is a certain community of the Christian faithful stably constituted in a particular church, whose pastoral care is entrusted to a pastor (*Code of Canon Law* #515). Therefore, it is important for parishioners to register for contact and pastoral reasons. You must have a sponsor letter from the parish in which each of the godparents reside. A godparent must have received the sacraments of Baptism, Penance, Holy Communion and, if married, have been married in the Catholic Church.

**Marriage:** Couples planning to be married must see a priest at least six months prior to the planned marriage. Couples seeking to be married at All Saints need to fulfill the All Saints pre-marriage process. The Wedding Coordinator and/or the Pastor will provide the couple with the guidelines and secure the date and time of the wedding. Do not set a date in advance until you have spoken to the pastor.

**Anointing of the Sick:** Please call the Parish Office if you or a member of your family need the Sacrament of Anointing.

**After Hours Sick Calls:** In case of serious illness after hours, please call 803-627-5297 and leave a message. Messages are checked regularly.
