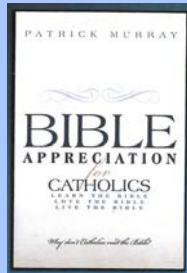


The **Faith Study Ministry** will present a new 1-hour DVD program this weekend, titled **“Reflections on the Passion”**. It is a documentary by some of the most respected voices in Catholic theology and apologetics today as they offer their personal, biblical and theological reflections on Our Lord's Passion.

This will be followed by a 6-week DVD series, **“A.D., The Trials & Triumph of the Early Church”**, which makes the **Book of Acts** come alive in this epic dramatization covering the years 30-69 A. D.

The Faith Study Group meets in the Father McGivney room in the Family Life Center at 9:30 am Sunday mornings.

This weekend after each Mass, there will be a display of a book titled: **Bible Appreciation for Catholics**. This book is an introduction to the Bible in a fresh new way that touches a number of topics related to the Bible and the Catholic laity. Bible appreciation is not the same as Bible study; it is an overview of the Bible. The book examines “Why Catholics don't read the Bible” and “What is the difference between a Catholic Bible and a Protestant Bible.” It goes into the origins and structure of the Bible. It looks at what is the Catholic Church's doctrine on the Bible in Vatican II's *Dogmatic Constitution on Divine Revelation* and other sources. The book helps the reader to get comfortable with the contents of the Bible and teaches how to navigate through the Bible. Come to the table in the Parish Life Center and take a look at this book. ## SACRAMENTS

**Baptism:** The celebration of Baptism is a moment of Grace for those to be baptized, for their families, and for the entire Parish Community. Preparation class is held the last Tuesday of each month at 7pm. Please call the office to RSVP. A Parish is a certain community of the Christian faithful stably constituted in a particular church, whose pastoral care is entrusted to a pastor (*Code of Canon Law #515*). Therefore, it is important for parishioners to register for contact and pastoral reasons. You must have a sponsor letter from the parish in which each of the godparents reside. A godparent must have received the sacraments of Baptism, Penance, Holy Communion and, if married, have been married in the Catholic Church.

**Marriage:** Couples planning to be married must see a priest at least six months prior to the planned marriage. Couples seeking to be married at All Saints need to fulfill the All Saints pre-marriage process. The Wedding Coordinator and/or the Pastor will provide the couple with the guidelines and secure the date and time of the wedding. Do not set a date in advance until you have spoken to the pastor.

**Anointing of the Sick:** Please call the Parish Office if you or a member of your family need the Sacrament of Anointing.

**After Hours Sick Calls:** In case of serious illness after hours, please call 803-627-5297 and leave a message. Messages are checked regularly.
