SACRAMENTS

Baptism: The celebration of Baptism is a moment of Grace for those to be baptized, for their families, and for the entire Parish Community. Preparation class is held the last Wednesday of each month at 7pm. Please call the office to RSVP. A Parish is a certain community of the Christian faithful stably constituted in a particular church, whose pastoral care is entrusted to a pastor (*Code of Canon Law #515*). Therefore, it is important for parishioners to register for contact and pastoral reasons. You must have a sponsor letter from the parish in which each of the godparents reside. A godparent must have received the sacraments of Baptism, Penance, Holy Communion and, if married, have been married in the Catholic Church.

Marriage: Couples planning to be married must see a priest at least six months prior to the planned marriage. Couples seeking to be married at All Saints need to fulfill the All Saints pre-marriage process. The Wedding Coordinator and/or the Pastor will provide the couple with the guidelines and secure the date and time of the wedding. Do not set a date in advance until you have spoken to the pastor.

Anointing of the Sick: Please call the Parish Office if you or a member of your family need the Sacrament of Anointing.

After Hours Sick Calls: In case of serious illness after hours, please call 803-493-1714 and leave a message.

FAST AND ABSTINENCE

Every person 14 years of age or older must abstain from meat (and items made with meat) on Good Friday, and every Friday of Lent. Every person between the ages of 18 and 59 must fast on Good Friday. Fasting consists of one full meal per day, with two smaller meals that do not add up to a full meal, and no snacks. There will be a personal dispensation by the Pastor for Friday, March 13th in honor of St. Patrick.



Food for Families

Water for USO



Since January 2019 the USO of NC Charlotte Airport Center has been serving an average of over 500 Servicemen, Servicewomen, and their families each day --- about 16,000 per month! The USO relies on donations to provide the food and refreshments to our military members and their families as they travel through the CLT airport. A major cost item is bottled water; they purchase and hand out over 300 cases of bottled water each month - - - at a cost of about \$1500 per month. In November you very generously donated over \$1,700 to support our USO; it was greatly appreciated by the Director of the USO for the Piedmont Area . . . and the many Servicemen, Servicewomen, and their families who visit our Center. **Our next quarterly USO Water Drive is at all Masses on 21-22 March.**

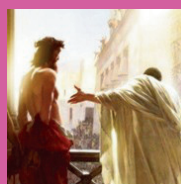


GriefShare is held on
