Baptism: The celebration of Baptism is a moment of Grace for those to be baptized, for their families, and for the entire Parish Community. Preparation class is held the last Wednesday of each month at 7pm. Please call the office to RSVP. A Parish is a certain community of the Christian faithful stably constituted in a particular church, whose pastoral care is entrusted to a pastor (*Code of Canon Law #515*). Therefore, it is important for parishioners to register for contact and pastoral reasons. You must have a sponsor letter from the parish in which each of the godparents reside. A godparent must have received the sacraments of Baptism, Penance, Holy Communion and, if married, have been married in the Catholic Church.

Marriage: Couples planning to be married must see a priest at least six months prior to the planned marriage. Couples seeking to be married at All Saints need to fulfill the All Saints pre-marriage process. The Wedding Coordinator and/or the Pastor will provide the couple with the guidelines and secure the date and time of the wedding. Do not set a date in advance until you have spoken to the pastor.

**Anointing of the Sick**: Please call the Parish Office if you or a member of your family need the Sacrament of Anointing.

**After Hours Sick Calls**: In case of serious illness after hours, please call 803-493-1714 and leave a message.

## Dear Parishioners,

We will follow the regular schedule of weekday and weekend Masses. Communion services will be on Tuesdays. Confessions can be heard on Saturdays from 4:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. The 8:00 a.m. Mass will be live streamed (www.allsaintslakewylie.com). If you are nervous about attending a weekend Mass due to the number of people, we encourage you to attend a daily Mass. We ask that anyone who is sick to remain home, as should vulnerable and at-risk populations. If you are over 65 years of age and have respiratory issues or are immunocompromised, please stay home. The Bishop has granted dispensation to those who are uncomfortable attending weekend Mass and those who are high risk until further notice.

There are restrictions and regulations that need to be followed to insure everyone's safety. These are safeguards that will be in place:

- The worship spaces are limited to 50% of capacity. Social distancing of six feet of separation is always to be maintained.
   St. Peter's room and the Parish Life Center are open for seating.
- Every other row will be cordoned off and only family members (same address) may sit closely together.
- Seats will be marked with blue tape and you will be directed to seats by ushers at the weekend Masses.
- There will be markings on the floor to guide you when going up to receive Communion.
   Communion will be received in the hand only.
- There will be no hymnals or missalettes. You
  may bring your personal missal or printed
  readings to church. We ask that you take them
  home with you at the end of Mass.
- Please wear masks out of respect for those around you. If you do not have a mask, the church will provide masks that should be returned after Mass to be sanitized.
- Hand sanitizer will be available at the entrance.
   Bathrooms will be available for emergencies only.
- Envelopes and cash offerings may be put in the wooden collection box at the entrance.

Thank you for your cooperation with implementing these safeguards.

# Stewardship Bulletin Reflection — June 28, 2020

## **Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time**

Today's readings take us back to some basics of stewardship living and demonstrate the genius of this way of life.

Our First Reading, from 2 Kings, shows us the necessity and power of hospitality. It recounts the story of a woman who showed loving hospitality to a visitor, inviting him to dinner with her family and arranging a room for him in their home so that he would have a comfortable place to stay during his travels through her town. She reached out to the man in a simple and practical manner to make him feel welcome and was rewarded in an extraordinary way.

In our Second Reading, from the Letter to the Romans, St. Paul reminds us of the power of our Baptism and how this sacrament makes us disciples. What does that mean for us here and now? St. Paul tells us very clearly: "You must think of yourselves as dead to sin and living for God in Christ Jesus." We must live for Christ! Nothing less will do.

Our Lord proclaims this same instruction in a rather shocking way in our Gospel passage from Matthew: "Whoever finds his life [by living for oneself] will lose it, and whoever loses his life for my sake will find it." But how do we lose our life? Precisely through loving actions towards others, loving them as if they were Christ. "Whoever gives only a cup of cold water to one of these little ones to drink because the little one is a disciple...he will surely not lose his reward."

The simple brilliance of stewardship living? Only our infinitely creative, compassionate God could conceive it!

## All Saints Safety Team Ministry

Dear Fellow Parishioners,

As you may be aware, our Parish Safety Team began forming around the 3rd quarter of 2019. Today our team consist of eighteen members providing coverage for all weekend Masses with support based on three key areas: medical, general safety and security. Our mission is to provide protection for clergy, staff, parishioners, and guests in the event of fire, medical emergencies, weather events, armed incursions and/or other emergencies that may occur during Mass and special events. As with any safety effort our primary objective is on prevention through observation, detection and eventual mitigation.

In order for the safety effort at All Saints to be successful, we ask for your support and cooperation at certain times and events. First, we are requesting no large carrying bags or backpacks be brought to church. When deemed necessary, please cooperate with the safety team if a search of contents is requested. Second, while on parish property if you should see suspicious activity or someone in need of medial attention, please contact any of our team members who can be identified by the round lapel pin (white outline with knight in armor in center). There is usually a safety team member at the church main entrance.

If you have any questions or would like additional information, please feel free to contact anyone from our safety team before or after Mass.




