SACRAMENTS

Baptism: The celebration of Baptism is a moment of Grace for those to be baptized, for their families, and for the entire Parish Community. Preparation class is held the last Wednesday of each month at 7pm. Please call the office to RSVP. A Parish is a certain community of the Christian faithful stably constituted in a particular church, whose pastoral care is entrusted to a pastor (*Code of Canon Law #515*). Therefore, it is important for parishioners to register for contact and pastoral reasons. You must have a sponsor letter from the parish in which each of the godparents reside. A godparent must have received the sacraments of Baptism, Penance, Holy Communion and, if married, have been married in the Catholic Church.

Marriage: Couples planning to be married must see a priest at least six months prior to the planned marriage. Couples seeking to be married at All Saints need to fulfill the All Saints pre-marriage process. The Wedding Coordinator and/or the Pastor will provide the couple with the guidelines and secure the date and time of the wedding. Do not set a date in advance until you have spoken to the pastor.

Anointing of the Sick: Please call the Parish Office if you or a member of your family need the Sacrament of Anointing.

After Hours Sick Calls: In case of serious illness after hours, please call 803-493-1714 and leave a message.

TODAY'S READINGS

First Reading — There is no salvation through anyone else. (Acts 4:8-12)

Psalm - "The stone rejected by the builders has become the cornerstone." (Psalm 118)

Second Reading — We are God's Children now. (1 John 3:1-2)

Gospel — The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep. (John 10:11-18)

Two metaphors in today's readings describe Jesus. Peter, drawing upon the words of the psalmist, calls Jesus the cornerstone. He is the foundation of our Christian faith, the one who conquered death and brought salvation to the world. In the Gospel, Jesus identifies himself as the Good Shepherd. He leads and cares for his sheep, even sheep outside the fold, eventually laying down his life for them, for us. Let us reflect on how Jesus is our cornerstone and our shepherd.

There are many resources in the Clover area for people who are in financial need. But did you know that All Saints regularly helps its own parishioners who are in a short-term financial crisis? Our St. Vincent de Paul fund here at All Saints continues to be a resource for those parishioners who are in a dire financial situation. If you are a registered parishioner in this type of situation now or in the future, please ask Father Ed for assistance. He will discreetly provide you with an application form for short-term financial assistance.

Did you know that our St. Vincent de Paul fund doesn't get funded by offertory envelopes or envelopes sent from the Diocese of Charleston? The funds come from the spontaneous generosity of our very own parishioners. There are two St. Vincent de Paul boxes in the Sanctuary - one as you exit at the back and one at the exit to your left. As you have passed by these boxes every weekend, you have dropped a dollar or two in those boxes enabling a fellow parishioner to stay in his home one more month or to keep the lights on until that next paycheck. Others of you have seen the boxes as you left Mass and said a prayer for your fellow parishioners. Knights of Columbus "Spring Clean Out" Collection Drive for Sweet Repeat Thrift Store Saturday May 15th from Noon – 4:00 PM All Saints Church Parking Lot

The Covid Pandemic has had a negative impact on many aspects of our community, including Lake Wylie's *Sweet Repeat Thrift Store*. After being forced to close for several months earlier this year due to Covid restrictions, the store reopened as of March 1st. However, donations have not returned to "pre-Covid" levels and revenue is down. The continued operation of the store impacts our community directly since it is operated by the *Sweet Repeat Charitable Foundation* (a 501 c3 non-profit), which has been supporting our local community services and activities for over 20 years. During the operating year of 2019-2020, over \$150,000 was distributed to more than 35 charitable organizations that provide needed services directly to our community. The Foundation distributes all its revenue after operating expenses, that is generated from the re-sale of donations of gently used clothing, housewares, small furniture and other small items.

We ask you to please continue to support the *Sweet Repeat Foundation* by donating items that you may have, that could be used by someone else and in the process support local community needs. Spring is the perfect time to clean-out, and support a great, local charitable organization in the process!
