SACRAMENTS

Baptism: The celebration of Baptism is a moment of Grace for those to be baptized, for their families, and for the entire Parish Community. Preparation class is held the last Wednesday of each month at 7pm. Please call the office to RSVP. A Parish is a certain community of the Christian faithful stably constituted in a particular church, whose pastoral care is entrusted to a pastor (*Code of Canon Law #515*). Therefore, it is important for parishioners to register for contact and pastoral reasons. You must have a sponsor letter from the parish in which each of the godparents reside. A godparent must have received the sacraments of Baptism, Penance, Holy Communion and, if married, have been married in the Catholic Church.

Marriage: Couples planning to be married must see a priest at least six months prior to the planned marriage. Couples seeking to be married at All Saints need to fulfill the All Saints pre-marriage process. The Wedding Coordinator and/or the Pastor will provide the couple with the guidelines and secure the date and time of the wedding. Do not set a date in advance until you have spoken to the pastor.

Anointing of the Sick: Please call the Parish Office if you or a member of your family need the Sacrament of Anointing.

After Hours Sick Calls: In case of serious illness after hours, please call 803-493-1714 and leave a message.

Parish Safety Notes



Active Shooter Response

We cannot ignore the recent incidents of violence in churches and schools across our country. It is prudent for all of us to have a plan, in advance, in the very rare possibility something were to happen in our very own parish.

Your safety team's primary focus is to keep weapon threats outside the church building. However, in the unlikely event of a live shooter incident inside the church, it is important that all parishioners not panic and start screaming and rushing for the exits. Only if comfortable with the decision, some parishioners closest to the shooter can help by immediately "swarming" the shooter while throwing kneelers and missals at him . . . distracting and confusing him with sheer numbers . . . allowing our security officers to quickly locate, move to, and engage the threat without further endangering our parishioners. EVERYONE ELSE should get down flat on the floor, where you are concealed from the shooter, no longer presenting him a target. Meanwhile, 911 will have been called and police will be responding. We pray we never see such an incident, but if we do, with your help, we will end it quickly with minimal harm to you. Questions? Please see our PST Emergency Procedures manual or ask any team member.
