Baptism: The celebration of Baptism is a moment of Grace for those to be baptized, for their families, and for the entire Parish Community. Preparation class is held the last Wednesday of each month at 7pm. Please call the office to RSVP. A Parish is a certain community of the Christian faithful stably constituted in a particular church, whose pastoral care is entrusted to a pastor (*Code of Canon Law #515*). Therefore, it is important for parishioners to register for contact and pastoral reasons. You must have a sponsor letter from the parish in which each of the godparents reside. A godparent must have received the sacraments of Baptism, Penance, Holy Communion and, if married, have been married in the Catholic Church.

Marriage: Couples planning to be married must see a priest at least six months prior to the planned marriage. Couples seeking to be married at All Saints need to fulfill the All Saints pre-marriage process. The Wedding Coordinator and/or the Pastor will provide the couple with the guidelines and secure the date and time of the wedding. Do not set a date in advance until you have spoken to the pastor.

Anointing of the Sick: Please call the Parish Office if you or a member of your family need the Sacrament of Anointing.

After Hours Sick Calls: In case of serious illness after hours, please call 803-493-1714 and leave a message.

TODAY'S READINGS

First Reading - All things are vanity! (Ecclesiastes 1:2; 2:21-23)

Psalm 90 - "If today you hear his voice, harden not your hearts."

Second Reading - In Christ you have died. In Christ you have been raised up.

(Colossians 3:1-5, 9-11)

Gospel - Avoid greed in all its forms. (Luke 12:13-21)

Today's readings are a wonderful antidote to our culture's attitude that the accumulation of material wealth should be everyone's goal. "Vanity of vanities," this notion is, for what guarantee is there that you will ever be able to enjoy all the wealth you worked for? Greed is idolatry, Paul says in the next reading; instead seek what is above. After all, Jesus points out in the Gospel, the rich man is a fool for thinking he can control the rest of his life through wealth. May today's readings offer a strong argument against the worship of material possessions.



Volunteers Needed

Most church emergencies are medical: fainting or dizziness, tripping, low or high blood sugar, chest pain, or heart attack. YOUR parish safety team has medical personnel at all Masses and parish events, but we need more people to cover all Masses and parish events throughout the coming year. The only qualification you need is wanting to help us. Both medically trained and inexperienced people are welcome. The safety team will train you in basic CPR and first aid and what procedures to follow until a medic arrives. Depending upon how many volunteers we have, your commitment could be only 2-3 hours per month to cover Masses and other events . . . assisting your fellow parishioners who may be in need. 
