


Baptism: The celebration of Baptism is a moment of Grace for those to be baptized, for their families, and for the entire Parish Community. Preparation class is held the last Wednesday of each month at 7pm. Please call the office to RSVP. A Parish is a certain community of the Christian faithful stably constituted in a particular church, whose pastoral care is entrusted to a pastor (*Code of Canon Law #515*). Therefore, it is important for parishioners to register for contact and pastoral reasons. You must have a sponsor letter from the parish in which each of the godparents reside. A godparent must have received the sacraments of Baptism, Penance, Holy Communion and, if married, have been married in the Catholic Church.

Marriage: Couples planning to be married must see a priest at least six months prior to the planned marriage. Couples seeking to be married at All Saints need to fulfill the All Saints pre-marriage process. The Wedding Coordinator and/or the Pastor will provide the couple with the guidelines and secure the date and time of the wedding. Do not set a date in advance until you have spoken to the pastor.

Anointing of the Sick: Please call the Parish Office if you or a member of your family need the Sacrament of Anointing.

After Hours Sick Calls: In case of serious illness after hours, please call 803-493-1714 and leave a message.

TODAY'S READINGS

First Reading - Because he demoralized the people, Jeremiah is condemned to death. (Jeremiah 38:4-6, 8-10)

Psalm 40 - "Lord, come to my aid!" Second Reading - We are surrounded by a cloud of witnesses, who can teach us how to struggle for glory. (Hebrews 12: 1-4)

Gospel - Jesus says: I have come to divide. (Luke 12:49-53)

We like to think of Jesus bringing peace and joy, healing and inspiration as he traveled from village to village with his disciples. But at this point in Luke's Gospel he is making his way to Jerusalem, where he knows what he will face, and his message has become sobering. The road to redemption is difficult. Jesus knew that sin and evil must be confronted. Our own encounters with sin and evil can be divisive, as Jesus warned his disciples. Most church emergencies are medical: fainting or dizziness, tripping, low or high blood sugar, chest pain, or heart attack. YOUR parish safety team has medical personnel at all Masses and parish events, but we need more people to cover all Masses and parish events throughout the coming year. The only qualification you need is wanting to help us. Both medically trained and inexperienced people are welcome. The safety team will train you in basic CPR and first aid and what procedures to follow until a medic arrives. Depending upon how many volunteers we have, your commitment could be only 2-3 hours per month to cover Masses and other events . . . assisting your fellow parishioners who may be in need.
