Baptism: The celebration of Baptism is a moment of Grace for those to be baptized, for their families, and for the entire Parish Community. Preparation class is held the last Wednesday of each month at 7pm. Please call the office to RSVP. A Parish is a certain community of the Christian faithful stably constituted in a particular church, whose pastoral care is entrusted to a pastor (*Code of Canon Law #515*). Therefore, it is important for parishioners to register for contact and pastoral reasons. You must have a sponsor letter from the parish in which each of the godparents reside. A godparent must have received the sacraments of Baptism, Penance, Holy Communion and, if married, have been married in the Catholic Church.

Marriage: Couples planning to be married must see a priest at least six months prior to the planned marriage. Couples seeking to be married at All Saints need to fulfill the All Saints pre-marriage process. The Wedding Coordinator and/or the Pastor will provide the couple with the guidelines and secure the date and time of the wedding. Do not set a date in advance until you have spoken to the pastor.

Anointing of the Sick: Please call the Parish Office if you or a member of your family need the Sacrament of Anointing.

After Hours Sick Calls: In case of serious illness after hours, please call 803-493-1714 and leave a message.

TODAY'S READINGS

Mass at 2:00 pm, 4:00 pm, 6:00 pm and 8:00pm Night: Isaiah 9:1-6; Psalm 96; Titus 2:11-14; Luke 2:1-14 In the darkness of this holy night, we celebrate the birth of the world's true light. The Prince of Peace, whom Isaiah prophesied and the angels proclaimed, was born to Mary in the city of David, wrapped in swaddling clothes, and laid in a simple manger. There was no room for him in the inn, so let us always make room for him in our hearts, our lives, and our world.

Dawn: Isaiah 62:11-12; Psalm 97; Titus 3:4-7; Luke 2:15-20 Isaiah prophesied that the Lord would proclaim that a savior would come and a people would be redeemed. On that night Jesus was born, the shepherds are the first to hear this proclamation. At once they go to Bethlehem. They find Mary, Joseph, and the infant, and they repeat the angels' message. When they leave, they glorify and praise God. May we accompany the shepherds this morning, find Jesus born in our midst, and give praise and thanks to God.


