SACRAMENTS

Baptism: The celebration of Baptism is a moment of Grace for those to be baptized, for their families, and for the entire Parish Community. Preparation class is held the last Wednesday of each month at 7pm. Please call the office to RSVP. A Parish is a certain community of the Christian faithful stably constituted in a particular church, whose pastoral care is entrusted to a pastor (*Code of Canon Law #515*). Therefore, it is important for parishioners to register for contact and pastoral reasons. You must have a sponsor letter from the parish in which each of the godparents reside. A godparent must have received the sacraments of Baptism, Penance, Holy Communion and, if married, have been married in the Catholic Church.

Marriage: Couples planning to be married must see a priest at least six months prior to the planned marriage. Couples seeking to be married at All Saints need to fulfill the All Saints pre-marriage process. The Wedding Coordinator and/or the Pastor will provide the couple with the guidelines and secure the date and time of the wedding. Do not set a date in advance until you have spoken to the pastor.

Anointing of the Sick: Please call the Parish Office if you or a member of your family need the Sacrament of Anointing.

After Hours Sick Calls: In case of serious illness after hours, please call 803-493-1714 and leave a message.

TODAY'S READINGS

First Reading - The Lord says: I will open your graves. (Ezekiel 37:12-14)

Psalm 130 - "With the Lord there is mercy and fullness of redemption."

Second Reading - The life-giving Spirit dwells in us. (Romans 8:8-11)

Gospel - The Lord says: Lazarus, come out! (John 11:1-45)

On this final Sunday of Lent before Palm Sunday, we hear Jesus call Lazarus forth from the tomb. Jesus calls us as well, calls us forth from our tombs of sin and death, where our harmful habits and attitudes separate us from God, from life. He is the resurrection. He is the life. Jesus' words to Martha then are His words to us now: Do you believe this? Do you believe that God can bring life out of death? Do you believe that God can free us from the burial bands of sin? Let us recover that faith within us and so prepare ourselves to witness the Resurrection.

FAST AND ABSTINENCE

Good Friday is an obligatory day of fast and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence. For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.

This month the Clover Area Assistance Center (CAAC) is in need of: canned meats (tuna, chicken, salmon, spam, ham), instant potatoes (boxed or bagged), flavored boxed potatoes (scaloped, Au gratin), canned greens (i.e., collards, turnip, spinach), canned vegetables (beets, asparagus, cabbage, mixed veggies), canned beans (cannellini, navy, black eyed peas, kidney and pinto), canned tomato products (stewed, crushed, whole, Manwich sauce), boxed stuffing, canned pork and beans, beanie weenies, instant brown rice, pasta, ramen noodles, macaroni and cheese, condiments (ketchup, mustard, mayo), soft breakfast bars, soft granola bars, jelly, toilet paper, and dish soap. PLEASE NO CANNED CORN or GREEN BEANS. These will be distributed to needy families in our community. Please take all food items for FOOD FOR FAMILIES to the main kitchen. Collection will take place the weekend of April 1st and 2nd. We collected 548 lbs. of food last month. The next food drive will be the weekend of May 6th and 7th.

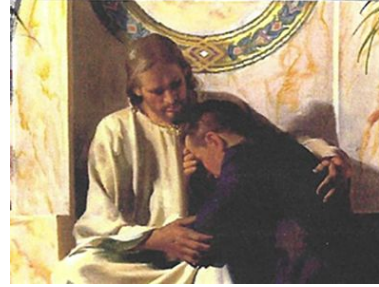
