SACRAMENTS

Baptism: The celebration of Baptism is a moment of Grace for those to be baptized, for their families, and for the entire Parish Community. Preparation class is held the last Wednesday of each month at 7pm. Please call the office to RSVP. A Parish is a certain community of the Christian faithful stably constituted in a particular church, whose pastoral care is entrusted to a pastor (*Code of Canon Law #515*). Therefore, it is important for parishioners to register for contact and pastoral reasons. You must have a sponsor letter from the parish in which each of the godparents reside. A godparent must have received the sacraments of Baptism, Penance, Holy Communion and, if married, have been married in the Catholic Church.

Marriage: Couples planning to be married must see a priest at least six months prior to the planned marriage. Couples seeking to be married at All Saints need to fulfill the All Saints pre-marriage process. The Wedding Coordinator and/or the Pastor will provide the couple with the guidelines and secure the date and time of the wedding. Do not set a date in advance until you have spoken to the pastor.

Anointing of the Sick: Please call the Parish Office if you or a member of your family need the Sacrament of Anointing.

After Hours Sick Calls: In case of serious illness after hours, please call 803-493-1714 and leave a message.

TODAY'S READINGS

First Reading - God gives repentance for our sins. (Wisdom 12:13, 16-19)
 Psalm 86 - "Lord, you are good and forgiving."
 Second Reading - The Spirit intercedes for us. (Romans 8:26-27)
 Gospel - Let the seeds grow together until harvest. (Matthew 13:24-30)

Today's first reading reminds us that God is both just and merciful: judging with clemency, governing with lenience. The farmer in Jesus' parable does the same, allowing weeds to grow alongside the wheat, waiting until harvest time to separate the two. God's justice is always tempered by mercy. Indeed, God sent the Son into the world, where he was put to death by unjust authorities, to bring mercy to all who seek forgiveness. Let us feel confident in placing our trust in our just and merciful God as we carry on in this imperfect world.



Parish Safety Team Notes
Please: No Firearms!!!



This is a reminder that **it is ILLEGAL in SC to carry a firearm into a church** . . . even if you have a Concealed Weapon Permit (CWP); see Section 23-31-215 of the South Carolina Code of Laws. **The felony consequences can be severe**, especially if you have a CWP which means you should know better . . . because you received the CWP training. **This is SERIOUS Business!** If you are carrying a firearm, you must leave it securely locked up in your vehicle in accordance with SC law; **do not bring it into the church**, either in your waistband, purse, handbag, or backpack. The only persons authorized to carry a firearm in our church are members of your Parish Safety Team (PST) who are South Carolina Law Enforcement Division (SLED) licensed. If you have any questions, please ask any safety team member for clarification. May God Bless!

An American Venerable - Father Al Schwartz

Al Schwartz was born on September 18, 1930 in Washington D.C. Al grew up during the Great Depression. His father struggled to make a living, and their family of 11 felt the pains of great poverty. Al studied theology at the Catholic University of Louvain in Belgium. After his ordination, his first assignment sent him to South Korea.

As soon as he arrived, Fr. Al saw the needs of the people and started a non-profit to raise funds. Recognizing that he could not fulfill God's call alone, he founded the Sisters of Mary. With their help, Fr. Al built Boystowns and Girlstowns where impoverished children lived, received an education, and encountered Christ.

He expanded his mission outside of South Korea to the Philippines. It was there that Fr. Al received his diagnosis of Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (ALS), also known as Lou Gehrig's Disease. Fr. Al always prayed to be united with the suffering Christ, so he gladly accepted this terminal illness. Even when confined to a wheelchair, he refused to stop his work and continued to celebrate Mass. Fr. Al passed away on March 16, 1992 at a Girlstown in the Philippines. The Sisters of Mary have continued his work, opening more Girlstowns and Boystowns around the world.

Pope Francis declared Fr. Al Schwartz venerable on January 22, 2015.
