Baptism: The celebration of Baptism is a moment of Grace for those to be baptized, for their families, and for the entire Parish Community. Preparation class is held the last Wednesday of each month at 7pm. Please call the office to RSVP. A Parish is a certain community of the Christian faithful stably constituted in a particular church, whose pastoral care is entrusted to a pastor (*Code of Canon Law #515*). Therefore, it is important for parishioners to register for contact and pastoral reasons. You must have a sponsor letter from the parish in which each of the godparents reside. A godparent must have received the sacraments of Baptism, Penance, Holy Communion and, if married, have been married in the Catholic Church.

Marriage: Couples planning to be married must see a priest at least six months prior to the planned marriage. Couples seeking to be married at All Saints need to fulfill the All Saints pre-marriage process. The Wedding Coordinator and/or the Pastor will provide the couple with the guidelines and secure the date and time of the wedding. Do not set a date in advance until you have spoken to the pastor.

Anointing of the Sick: Please call the Parish Office if you or a member of your family need the Sacrament of Anointing.

After Hours Sick Calls: In case of serious illness after hours, please call 803-493-1714 and leave a message.

An American Venerable - Venerable Mother Mary Elizabeth Lange


Elizabeth Lange's parents were Cuban immigrants from modern-day Haiti. Elizabeth's father had a solid financial and social standing, which allowed her to receive a good education. As a young adult, she emigrated to the United States in search of security and a better life. Providence led her to Baltimore, Maryland where a group of fellow Cuban refugees had settled.

Elizabeth quickly realized the need for education among the refugee children. However, living in Baltimore before the Emancipation Proclamation meant that the education of slaves was illegal, and she was a woman of color. Elizabeth did not let this impediment stop her mission. She opened a school for black children in her own home using her own money. As time went on, finances started to become an issue. Elizabeth connected with Fr. James Hector Joubert, S.S., who provided direction and financial assistance, and encouraged Elizabeth to start an order.


On July 2, 1829, Elizabeth and three other women pronounced promises of poverty, chastity, and obedience. The Oblate Sisters of Providence was the first African American women's religious order in the U. S.

Elizabeth took on the name Mother Mary and served as superior general for nine years. The Sisters served the sick during two cholera epidemics and helped take care of the housekeeping tasks around St. Mary's seminary. Mother Mary gave everything she had until she had nothing except for the Lord and then she still gave. She trusted in providence through many setbacks – the death of her greatest supporter, Fr. Joubert, being abandoned by some of her closest friends and coworkers, acts of racism, and poverty. Mother Mary continued to serve until the Lord called her home on February 3, 1882.

Pope Francis declared Mother Mary Elizabeth venerable on June 22, 2023.

September 17, 2023 Twenty-fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Today's readings call us to look inward to the state of our hearts, our thoughts and emotions.

Our first reading, from Sirach, addresses the complicated emotion of anger. "Could anyone nourish anger against another and expect healing from the Lord?" We have all been wounded by others at some point, some perhaps quite deeply. Our emotions are gifts from God. But we must steward them well, rather than allowing them to overcome us.

How do we do this? Sirach tells us. "Remember your last days, set enmity aside... Remember the Most High's covenant and overlook faults." We embrace the stewardship mindset — not brooding over hurts, but recalling all the gifts our good God has given us, all the love He continually pours out upon us, and we put our focus and trust in Him.

In our Gospel passage from Matthew, Jesus reminds us of the true position we have before Him in light of all that He has done for us, comparing the kingdom of heaven to a "king who decided to settle accounts with his servants." In the parable, a debtor is brought before the king, owing such an overwhelming debt that it could not possibly be repaid. Yet, the king is filled with compassion for the servant, forgives the debt and lets him go free.

Doesn't that sound like each of us in relation to the King of Kings? The Father has given us life, and then sent His only Son to die for us to free us from our sin "debts" and make eternal life with Him possible for us. It is impossible for us to repay this debt. All we can do is thank God by giving Him our whole selves — inside and out.




