Baptism: The celebration of Baptism is a moment of Grace for those to be baptized, for their families, and for the entire Parish Community. Preparation class is held the last Wednesday of each month at 7pm. Please call the office to RSVP. A Parish is a certain community of the Christian faithful stably constituted in a particular church, whose pastoral care is entrusted to a pastor (Code of Canon Law #515). Therefore, it is important for parishioners to register for contact and pastoral reasons. You must have a sponsor letter from the parish in which each of the godparents reside. A godparent must have received the sacraments of Baptism, Penance, Holy Communion and, if married, have been married in the Catholic Church.

Marriage: Couples planning to be married must see a priest at least six months prior to the planned marriage. Couples seeking to be married at All Saints need to fulfill the All Saints pre-marriage process. The Wedding Coordinator and/or the Pastor will provide the couple with the guidelines and secure the date and time of the wedding. Do not set a date in advance until you have spoken to the pastor.

Oplatki Christmas Tradition

Polish, Slovak, and Lithuanian families observe this centuries-old tradition. The word Oplatki means "Angel Bread". The wafers come with Christmas images stamped on the wafer. Each wafer comes in an envelope with the Oplatki tradition printed on the back.

A wafer is broken by the head of the family and distributed to each member with a simple prayer for God's grace and the welfare of the present and absent members of the family. Each member of the family is wished a joyful feast.

The spiritual lesson in this age-old custom is unity of the family - the main pillar of society. The bond of unity is the Christ-like charity that should exist amongst the members of the family. Family customs remind us that we seek and obtain salvation with the help of others at all times."


