SACRAMENTS

Baptism: The celebration of Baptism is a moment of Grace for those to be baptized, for their families, and for the entire Parish Community. Preparation class is held the last Wednesday of each month at 7pm. Please call the office to RSVP. A Parish is a certain community of the Christian faithful stably constituted in a particular church, whose pastoral care is entrusted to a pastor (*Code of Canon Law #515*). Therefore, it is important for parishioners to register for contact and pastoral reasons. You must have a sponsor letter from the parish in which each of the godparents reside. A godparent must have received the sacraments of Baptism, Penance, Holy Communion and, if married, have been married in the Catholic Church.

Marriage: Couples planning to be married must see a priest at least six months prior to the planned marriage. Couples seeking to be married at All Saints need to fulfill the All Saints pre-marriage process. The Wedding Coordinator and/or the Pastor will provide the couple with the guidelines and secure the date and time of the wedding. Do not set a date in advance until you have spoken to the pastor.

Anointing of the Sick: Please call the Parish Office if you or a member of your family need the Sacrament of Anointing.

After Hours Sick Calls: In case of serious illness after hours, please call 803-493-1714 and leave a message.

TODAY'S READINGS

First Reading - The Lord's promise to Abram and Sarah is fulfilled. (Genesis 15:1-6, 21:1-3)
 Psalm 105 - "The Lord remembers his covenant forever."
 Second Reading - The faith of Abraham, Sarah, and Isaac. (Hebrews 11:8, 11-12, 17-19)
 Gospel - The child grew and became strong, filled with wisdom. (Luke 2:22-40)

Faith and trust in God are vital in a family. Abraham and Sarah's faith is rewarded in a son, born at long last. The reading from Hebrews relates the same story, but also of how later Abraham stood ready to sacrifice Isaac, trusting that God must somehow be able to save his son. Mary and Joseph's faith leads them to the temple to present their son according to the law, where Simeon and Anna recognize their Savior. Listening to God's word, let us witness the strong faith of these holy men and women.

FOOD DRIVE

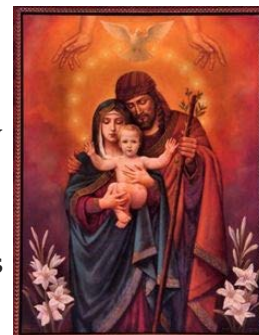


The All Saints Council of the Knights of Columbus is sponsoring a food drive as part of their Food for Families Program. This month the Clover Area Assistance Center (CAAC) is in need of: canned meats (tuna, chicken, salmon, spam, ham), instant potatoes (boxed or bagged), flavored boxed potatoes (scalloped, Au gratin), canned greens (i.e., collards, turnip, spinach), canned vegetables (beets, asparagus, cabbage, mixed veggies), canned beans (cannellini, navy, black eyed peas, kidney and pinto), canned tomato products (stewed, crushed, whole, Manwich sauce), boxed stuffing, canned pork and beans, beanie weenies, instant brown rice, pasta, ramen noodles, macaroni and cheese, condiments (ketchup, mustard, mayo), soft breakfast bars, soft granola bars, jelly, toilet paper, and dish soap. PLEASE NO CANNED CORN or GREEN BEANS. These will be distributed to needy families in our community. Please take all food items for FOOD FOR FAMILIES to the main kitchen. Collection will take place the weekend of January 6th and 7th. We collected 186# of food last month. The next food drive will be the weekend of February 3rd and 4th.

Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph

Today we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph. They are a model for all families! And just as the Holy Family is holy, our families, too, are called to be holy. This may seem like a daunting task at times! Yet, as Christian stewards we know that this holiness is achievable by living as disciples of Christ.



Our First Reading, from the book of Sirach, teaches us about reverence and honor of the members of our family, particularly the elders. “My son, take care of your father when he is old... even if his mind fails, be considerate of him.” No matter our age, we are called to serve and honor our family members. Sometimes loving and serving those closest to us can be the hardest. But we have to remember that our families are a gift from God, and it is in serving them that we show our gratitude for this gift.

What more can we do to honor the blessing of family? St. Paul shares in our Second Reading a word of advice on how we can do just that. He calls us to put on “heartfelt compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience, bearing with one another and forgiving one another... as the Lord has forgiven you, so must you also do.” This is how we ought to treat our family — with the love, compassion and mercy that God gives to us. If God can see every thought in our mind and every action we commit, good and bad, and never change His love for us, can we not share that same love and mercy with our family members? God has been so generous to us, so let us “[give] thanks to God the Father” by being good stewards of His love and mercy in our homes, and to our family members both near and far.

Our Gospel today says a great deal about trust and surrender to our Lord — two trademark words of a steward. As the Holy Family brought the Infant Jesus to the temple, they encountered two key individuals, Simeon and Anna. Upon seeing the Infant, both praised the Lord, rejoiced in the coming of their Savior and prophesized about what was to come. It says, “the child’s father and mother were amazed at what was said about him.” We can imagine that two parents would be taken back by these words! Yet, through all this, the Holy Family surrendered their lives to God and had unwavering faith and trust in His plan. Thankfully, they did, because the fulfillment of this plan meant salvation for man!

Believe it or not, God has a plan for our lives, too. Oftentimes, we get in the way of what He has in store for us. Although our plan might be “good,” God’s plan is great and will fulfill our hearts more than we could have ever imagined. Like the Holy Family, we just need to trust, surrender and be attentive to God’s voice.

As we celebrate this Christmas season with joy and gladness for our Savior, let us deepen our commitment to Him through the love and service we give our family members, and the trust and surrender we place in God to take care of us each day. ©Catholic Stewardship Consultants
