## SACRAMENTS

**Baptism:** The celebration of Baptism is a moment of Grace for those to be baptized, for their families, and for the entire Parish Community. Preparation class is held the last Wednesday of each month at 7pm. Please call the office to RSVP. A Parish is a certain community of the Christian faithful stably constituted in a particular church, whose pastoral care is entrusted to a pastor (*Code of Canon Law #515*). Therefore, it is important for parishioners to register for contact and pastoral reasons. You must have a sponsor letter from the parish in which each of the godparents reside. A godparent must have received the sacraments of Baptism, Penance, Holy Communion and, if married, have been married in the Catholic Church.

**Marriage:** Couples planning to be married must see a priest at least six months prior to the planned marriage. Couples seeking to be married at All Saints need to fulfill the All Saints pre-marriage process. The Wedding Coordinator and/or the Pastor will provide the couple with the guidelines and secure the date and time of the wedding. Do not set a date in advance until you have spoken to the pastor.

**Anointing of the Sick:** Please call the Parish Office if you or a member of your family need the Sacrament of Anointing.

**After Hours Sick Calls:** In case of serious illness after hours, please call 312-925-9960 and leave a message.

## TODAY'S READINGS

First Reading - God's law is planted in our hearts. (Deuteronomy 20:10-14)

Psalm 69 - "Turn to the Lord in your need, and you will live."

Second Reading - In the cross all creation is united in Christ. (Colossians 1:15-20)

Gospel - Even the stranger is to be loved as a neighbor. (Luke 10:25-37)

Today we hear the story of the good Samaritan, the parable that Jesus told to explain how far-reaching the concept of *neighbor* is and how to show love to our neighbor in need. Remember, Samaritans were looked down upon by the Jewish people in that era. If even *Samaritans* were neighbors, then everyone was. If this undesirable Samaritan is the only person willing to minister to this injured man, we should do the same, ministering to anyone in need, no matter how different they are. May we heed this lesson today just as Jesus taught it two thousand years ago.

### **Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time**

Today’s readings show us how to follow God’s commands and to live our lives as a gift in service to others.

The First Reading, from the ancient book of Deuteronomy, reminds us that God’s laws are not inaccessible to us. Rather, they are written on our very hearts. Moses says to the people in today’s passage that God’s commands are “very near to you, already in your mouths and in your hearts; you have only to carry [them] out.” And as we see in today’s Gospel passage, God gives us these laws so that we may inherit eternal life. God’s commands are meant to lead us to Heaven.

In our Second Reading, from St. Paul’s letter to the Colossians, we see God’s instruction made even more explicit, in the very person of His Son, Jesus Christ. The Father has sent His own Son to demonstrate how to obey Him and to give us a living example of how we should live our lives as a gift. As St. Paul says, “Christ Jesus is the image of the invisible God.”

Finally, in today’s Gospel passage, from Luke, we read the well-known parable of the Good Samaritan. The first thing we note about the Good Samaritan is that he is aware of the needs of those around him and responds generously. While the priest and Levi brush right past the man on the side of the road, the Samaritan is watching for those who might be in need. He has a hospitable way of looking at the world around him and so he is able to “see” in a way that the others did not, and he was “moved with compassion at the sight” of the man.

Next, we see the Good Samaritan spring into action to serve this man, setting aside his own schedule and plans in order to meet his needs. He does not just give the man a few dollars or offer some quick words of encouragement from across the road. He goes right up to the man. He cleans and bandages his wounds. He puts the man on his own animal and brings him to an inn where he can heal. He ensures that the innkeeper would continue to look after him and he commits to returning to the man on his way back.

This type of hospitality and generosity in serving others is essential. Do we have this same hospitable openness to others around us, both to those who may feel on the outskirts of our parish family and to those “on the margins” of our wider community? What can we do to become more aware of the needs of others and more open to setting aside our own plans to care for those needs?

That is how we live out God’s commandments. That is true hospitality and service. And Jesus says to each of us personally, just as He did in today’s Gospel, “Go and do likewise.”
