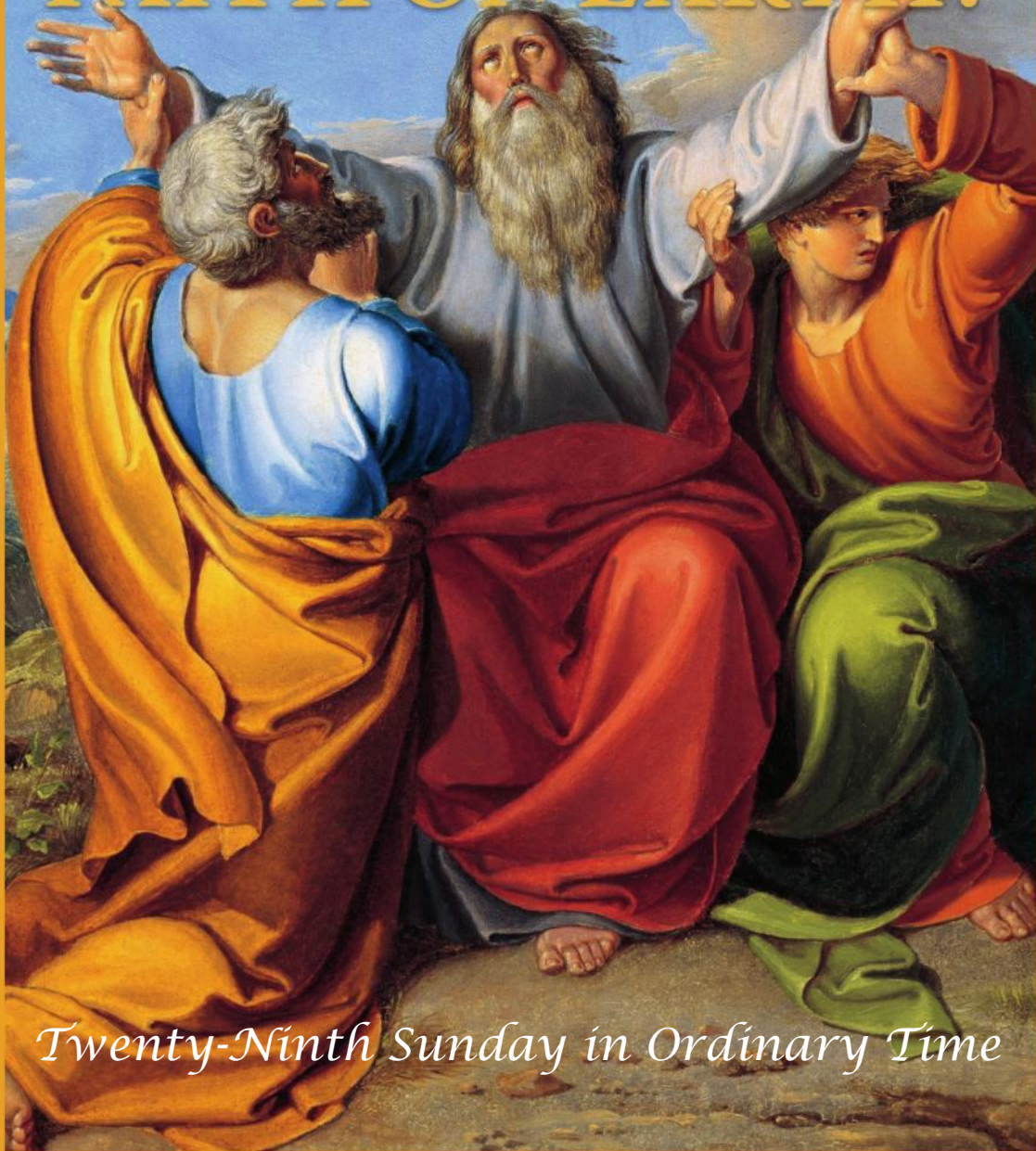

SACRAMENTS

Baptism: The celebration of Baptism is a moment of Grace for those to be baptized, for their families, and for the entire Parish Community. Preparation class is held the last Wednesday of each month at 7pm. Please call the office to RSVP. A Parish is a certain community of the Christian faithful stably constituted in a particular church, whose pastoral care is entrusted to a pastor (*Code of Canon Law #515*). Therefore, it is important for parishioners to register for contact and pastoral reasons. You must have a sponsor letter from the parish in which each of the godparents reside. A godparent must have received the sacraments of Baptism, Penance, Holy Communion and, if married, have been married in the Catholic Church.

Marriage: Couples planning to be married must see a priest at least six months prior to the planned marriage. Couples seeking to be married at All Saints need to fulfill the All Saints pre-marriage process. The Wedding Coordinator and/or the Pastor will provide the couple with the guidelines and secure the date and time of the wedding. Do not set a date in advance until you have spoken to the pastor.

Anointing of the Sick: Please call the Parish Office if you or a member of your family need the Sacrament of Anointing.

After Hours Sick Calls: In case of serious illness after hours, please call 312-925-9960 and leave a message.

First Reading - As long as Moses kept his hands raised up, Israel had the better of the fight. (Exodus 17:8-13)

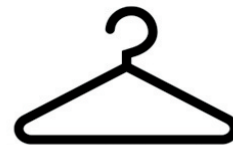
Psalm 121 - “Our help is from the Lord, who made heaven and earth.”

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES SUMMARY



Lapel Pin identifies Parish Safety Team members

MEDICAL ASSISTANCE: Contact any Parish Safety Team (PST) member ASAP. Notice "Reserved Medical Team" chair drapes during Masses.

FIRE ALARM: CALMLY EVACUATE TO MEETING AREA: Water sprinklers might activate and Fire Department will come automatically but all adults and children must quickly and calmly evacuate the buildings including kitchens, rest rooms, classrooms, and meeting rooms. Do not delay and please assist children, those with canes, walkers, and wheel chairs. Unless you are trained do not try to extinguish fire. Never use elevators. Move to EVACUATION MEETING AREAS (see other side) far end of parking lot away from danger. Wait for directions. Do not enter or drive your vehicle. Emergency vehicles will be speeding into entrance and exit and must not be blocked. Stay in EVACUATION MEETING AREAS (see other side) to account for adults and children. Wait for all clear.

CLERGY ANNOUNCES TORNADO WARNING, SHELTER INSIDE: All adults and children must quickly move to non-window areas INSIDE BUILDING. Left side of church moves to storage room and Sacristy (shelter away from windows). Right side of church and classrooms move to 1st floor kitchens and hall near PLC (shelter away from windows). Wait for "all clear."

NUCLEAR EMERGENCY CATAWBA NUCLEAR POWER PLANT SIRENS, WAIT FOR INSTRUCTIONS: Outside sirens will indicate a real nuclear emergency OR a test. Clergy and/or PST will advise to either SHELTER INSIDE or TESTING SYSTEM no action.

BOMB THREAT, WAIT FOR INSTRUCTIONS: Based on Law Enforcement direction, Clergy or PST will announce shelter inside, evacuate and leave, or evacuate to meeting area. Wait for and follow instructions. NEVER TOUCH SUSPICIOUS PACKAGES or use your phone nearby. Notify a PST member ASAP.

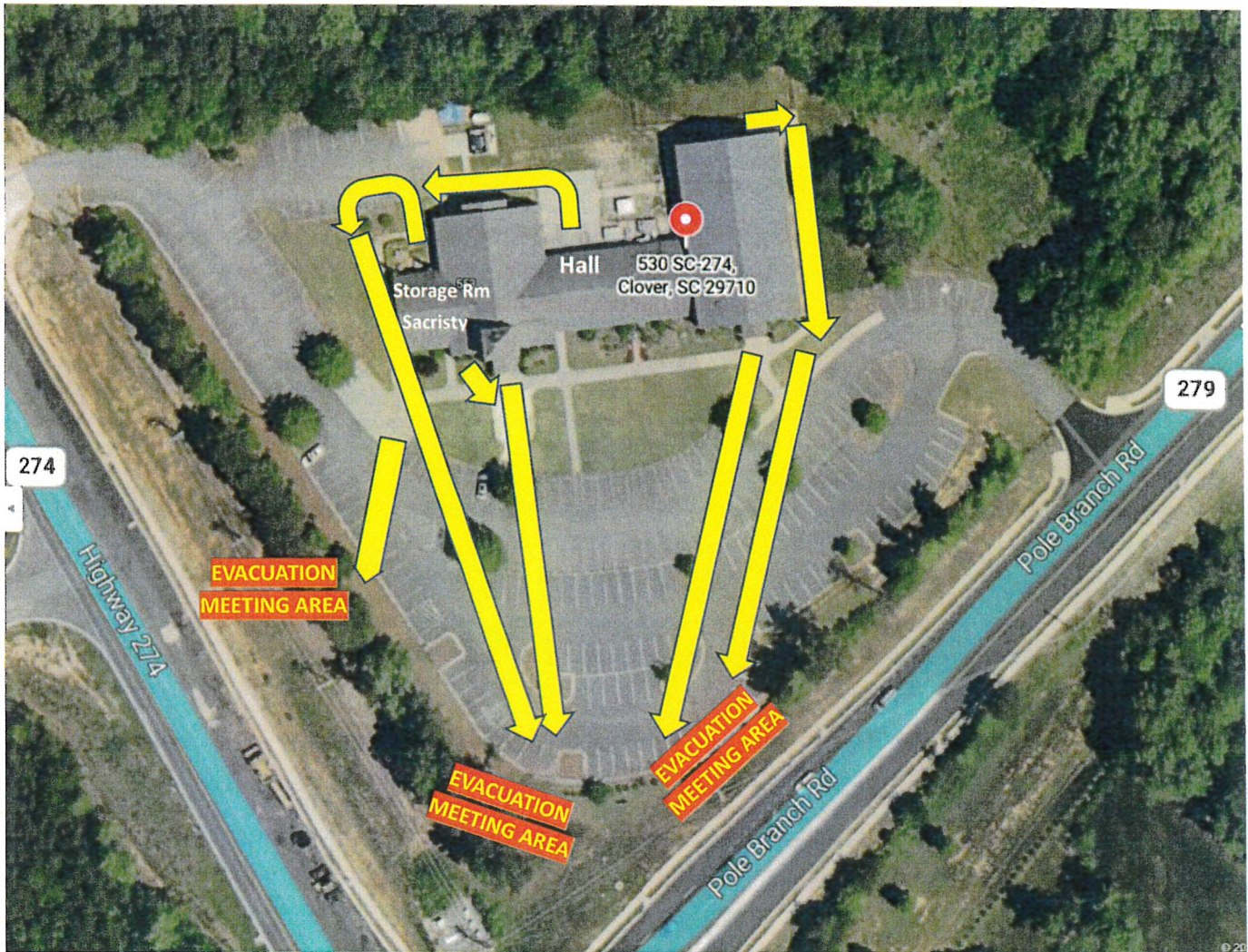
ACTIVE SHOOTER, GET CLOSE TO FLOOR: Act quickly to get yourself and family on the floor. Do not panic, yell, or run into the path of danger. PST Security members will call 911 and together with Law Enforcement keep the threat outside and/or address the threat inside. Do not run out of doors as this could allow shooters to enter. Security will alert teachers to deploy classroom lockdown protocol. PST Armed Security will wear a fluorescent SECURITY sash, Medical/Safety will wear a bright fluorescent sash. Never prop open a door or let anyone inside. Wait for POLICE "all clear" before moving from the floor. After the event remain calm. Stay in buildings. Police will treat everyone as a possible threat until cleared. Be calm, empty hands visible, no sudden movements. Never run toward law enforcement unless asked.

Parish Safety Team (PST) members are volunteer-parishioners. SLED Armed Security Officers are part of KDI Protective Services. PST members receive training to serve clergy, parishioners, and visitors. Members are either MEDICAL, SAFETY, or ARMED SECURITY.
